

CHURCH WARDEN'S FABRIC REPORT

St. Hilda's Church A.P.C.M. 2017

During 2014 The Quinquennium Inspection was carried out.

We are pleased to report that the majority of works required in that inspection have been completed.

However, outstanding jobs are;

- Redecorating External Joinery
- Fitting Sump into Pit in the Boiler Room
- Installing guard around Boiler Room Steps
- Insulation to the main nave roof
- Remove door closer to the toilet and fit alarm
- Resurface Tarmac drive to West side and South side
- Replace where necessary and re-lay slab path alongside the church and at rear door to the church
- Install exterior lighting to top of drive to improve safer access to front of church during winter period

Jobs we have carried out this year

- Roof has been completely repaired
- Rainwater goods have been redecorated and cleaned
- Flat roofs have been cleaned and some repair work carried out
- Gas meter cupboard has been renewed
- Complete new lighting in church to L.E.D.'s
- Cable to Scout Hut laid and installed
- CCTV installed
- Improvements work carried out in Choir Gallery
- Replaced new heaters in the Vicar's vestry and Choir vestry.

- Update access to loft area and to convert the space into an upper room
- Re-design main entrance (These two items are for future consideration)
- A radiator has been fitted into the Guides' room

This building is greatly loved by everyone who worships here, and we must recognise the silent and continuous work carried out with regularity and no fuss.
